I am requesting funding for the Strategic Property Acquisition in Support of the Lowell Innovation Network Corridor Project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the University of Massachusetts Lowell, located at 220 Pawtucket Street, Suite 420, Lowell, MA 01854. The funding would be used for the purchase and rehabilitation of an existing building on West Adams Street and adjacent land to advance the ongoing Lowell Innovation Network Corridor (LINC) initiative. Led by the University of Massachusetts Lowell (UML) in collaboration with public and private sector partners, LINC will transform the campus and downtown Lowell into an innovation district supporting research, entrepreneurship, and workforce development.
