Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Locke Street Sewer Separation Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Haverhill, located at 4 Summer Street, Haverhill, MA 01830. The funding would be used to support the separation of approximately 27,000 linear feet (LF) of combined sewers in the Locke Street area of the City. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will directly contribute to the reduction of combined sewer overflows (CSOs) in the Merrimack River. This project has clear public health benefits for the Haverhill community and when completed, will allow for additional sewer capacity to support future economic development in the City.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
