(c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
209 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
1022h) is amended by striking "\$300,000,000" and all
that follows and inserting "\$600,000,000 for fiscal years
2022 through 2024 and such sums as may be necessary
for each succeeding fiscal year."
