Whereas there is a critical need for increased participation in cardiovascular intervention clinical trials by women; and

Whereas there exists a lack of awareness about treatment options for women, including technologies to enable heart recovery or heart muscle recovery, which enables a superior quality of life following a heart event: Now, therefore, be it
